WHAT IS AN APF?

An APF is an Administrative Program Fee. APFs are charged at the point of sale for new appliances sold in BC. It's not a tax, nor is it a refundable deposit.

APFs for different products are established by MARR having regard to the cost to recycle the materials contained in the product and the cost of administering the program generally.

Here are the fees for appliances covered by the MARR stewardship plan:
